## A BILL

To repeal the telephone excise tax.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPEAL OF TELEPHONE EXCISE TAX.
- 4 (a) In General.—Effective with respect to amounts
- 5 paid pursuant to bills first rendered on or after January
- 6 1, 1999, subchapter B of chapter 33 of the Internal Reve-
- 7 nue Code of 1986 (26 U.S.C. 4251 et seq.) is repealed.
- 8 For purposes of the preceding sentence, in the case of
- 9 communications services rendered before December 1,
- 10 1998, for which a bill has not been rendered before Janu-
- 11 ary 1, 1999, a bill shall be treated as having been first
- 12 rendered on December 31, 1998.

- 1 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Effective January
- 2 1, 1999, the table of subchapters for such chapter is

3 amended by striking out the item relating to subchapter

4 B.
