# S. 977

## AN ACT

To provide for the conveyance by the Bureau of Land Management to Douglas County, Oregon, of a county park and certain adjacent land.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Miwaleta Park Expan-
- 5 sion Act".

1	SEC. 2. LAND CONVEYANCE, BUREAU OF LAND MANAGE-
2	MENT LAND, DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON.
3	(a) In General.—
4	(1) Conveyance.—The Secretary of the Inte-
5	rior (referred to in this section as the "Secretary")
6	shall convey, without consideration, to Douglas
7	County, Oregon (referred to in this section as the
8	"County"), all right, title, and interest of the United
9	States in and to a parcel of land (including improve-
10	ments on the land) described in paragraph (2) and
11	consisting of—
12	(A) Miwaleta Park, a county park man-
13	aged under agreement by the County on Fed-
14	eral land managed by the Bureau of Land Man-
15	agement; and
16	(B) an adjacent tract of Federal land man-
17	aged by the Bureau of Land Management.
18	(2) Legal description.—The parcel of land
19	referred to in paragraph (1) is the parcel in the
20	SW½ of the NE½; SE½ of the NW½ of sec. 27,
21	T. 31 S., R. 4 W., W.M., Douglas County, Oregon,
22	described as follows:
23	The property lying between the southerly right-
24	of-way line of the relocated Cow Creek County
25	Road No. 36 and contour elevation 1881.5
26	MSL, comprising approximately 28.50 acres.

### (b) Use of Land.—

(1) In General.—After conveyance of land under subsection (a), the County shall manage the land for public park purposes in a manner so as not to adversely affect attainment of the objectives of the adjacent Late Successional Reserve as described in the Northwest Forest Plan, and in accordance with a management plan for the area developed in cooperation with the United States Fish and Wildlife Service.

#### (2) Reversionary interest.—

- (A) IN GENERAL.—If the Secretary determines that the land conveyed under subsection
  (a) is not being used for public park purposes, at the option of the Secretary—
  - (i) all right, title, and interest in and to the land, including any improvements on the land, shall revert to the United States; and
  - (ii) the United States shall have the right of immediate entry onto the land.
- (B) DETERMINATION ON THE RECORD.—
  Any determination of the Secretary under subparagraph (A) shall be made on the record.

- 1 (c) Survey.—The exact acreage and legal descrip-
- 2 tion of the land to be conveyed under subsection (a) shall
- 3 be determined by a survey satisfactory to the Secretary
- 4 and paid for by the County.
- 5 (d) IMPACT ON FERC WITHDRAWAL.—
- 6 (1) In General.—The conveyance of land
- 7 under subsection (a) shall have no effect on the con-
- 8 ditions and rights provided in Federal Energy Regu-
- 9 latory Commission Withdrawal No. 7161.
- 10 (2) Conflicts.—In a case of conflict between
- the use of the conveyed land as a park and the pur-
- poses of the withdrawal, the purposes of the with-
- drawal shall prevail.
- (e) Costs of Conveyance.—Except as provided in
- 15 subsection (c), costs associated with the conveyance under
- 16 subsection (a) shall be borne by the party incurring the
- 17 costs.
- 18 (f) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The Sec-
- 19 retary may require such additional terms and conditions
- 20 in connection with the conveyance under subsection (a) as

- 1 the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
- 2 ests of the United States.
