- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "George Washington
- 5 Bicentennial Act of 1999".
- 6 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY.
- 7 The legal public holiday know as "Washington's
- 8 Birthday" as specified in section 6103 of title 5, United
- 9 States Code, shall be referred to by that name and no
- 10 other—

1	(1) by all entities and officials of the United
2	States Government; and
3	(2) whenever it appears in any federally funded
4	publications.
