A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the Surface Transportation Board for fiscal years 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Surface Transpor-
5 tation Board Reauthorization Act of 1999”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION LEVELS.**

7 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sur-
8 face Transportation Board \$16,000,000 for fiscal year

1 1999, \$17,000,000 for fiscal year 2000, \$17,555,000 for
2 fiscal year 2001, and \$18,129,000 for fiscal year 2002.

3 **SEC. 3. CHAIRMAN DESIGNATED WITH SENATE CONFIRMA-**
4 **TION.**

5 Section 701(c)(1) of title 49, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking “President” and inserting “Presi-
7 dent, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,”.
