

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Thursday, May 27, 1999, on
4 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
5 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
6 or adjourned until noon on Monday, June 7, 1999, or until
7 such time on that day as may be specified by its Majority
8 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,
9 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
10 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
11 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the House
12 adjourns on the legislative day of Thursday, May 27,
13 1999, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-
14 olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
15 adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Monday, June 7, 1999, for
16 morning-hour debate, or until noon on the second day
17 after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to sec-
18 tion 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

1 SEC. 2. The Majority Leader of the Senate and the
2 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
3 with the Minority Leader of the Senate and the Minority
4 Leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
5 ate and House, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
6 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
