Mr. CAMPBELL submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Senate regarding the United States share of any reconstruction measures undertaken in the Balkans region of Europe on account of the armed conflict and atrocities that have occurred in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia since March 24, 1999.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. SENSE OF SENATE ON UNITED STATES SHARE**
3 **OF RECONSTRUCTION COSTS.**

4 It is the sense of the Senate that the United States
5 share of the total costs of reconstruction measures carried
6 out in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia or contiguous
7 countries, on account of the armed conflict and atrocities

1 that have occurred in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia
 2 since March 24, 1999, should not exceed the United
 3 States percentage share of the common-funded budgets of
 4 NATO.

5 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

6 In this resolution:

7 (1) COMMON-FUNDED BUDGETS OF NATO.—

8 The term “common-funded budgets of NATO”
 9 means—

10 (A) the Military Budget, the Security In-
 11 vestment Program, and the Civil Budget of
 12 NATO; and

13 (B) any successor or additional account or
 14 program of NATO.

15 (2) FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA.—The
 16 term “Federal Republic of Yugoslavia” means the
 17 Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Monte-
 18 negro) and includes Kosovo.

19 (3) UNITED STATES PERCENTAGE SHARE OF
 20 THE COMMON-FUNDED BUDGETS OF NATO.—The
 21 term “United States percentage share of the com-
 22 mon-funded budgets of NATO” means the percent-
 23 age that the total of all United States payments dur-
 24 ing a fiscal year to the common-funded budgets of
 25 NATO represent to the total amounts payable by all

- 1 NATO members to those budgets during that fiscal
- 2 year.
