RESOLUTION

To authorize representation of Members of the Senate in the case of Candis Ray v. John Edwards, et al.

Whereas, in the case of Candis O. Ray v. John Edwards, et al., Case No. 99–CV–1104–EGS, pending in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, the plaintiff has named as defendants Senator Trent Lott and Senator John Edwards; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a) and 288c(a)(1), the Senate may direct its counsel to defend Members of the Senate in civil actions relating to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is directed
2 to represent Senator Lott and Senator Edwards in the
3 case of Candis O. Ray v. John Edwards, et al.
