- 6 taken between the first and second sessions of the 106th
- 7 Congress in order to allow the Senate Commission on Art
- 8 to carry out its responsibilities to publish a Senate docu-
- 9 ment containing works of art, historical objects, and exhib-
- 10 its within the Senate Wing.

- 2 thorized and directed to make the necessary arrangements
