Mr. LOTT (for himself and Mr. DASCHLE) submitted the following resolution;

## RESOLUTION

Authorizing the taking of photographs in the Chamber of  
the United States Senate.

1       *Resolved*, That paragraph 1 of rule IV of the Rules  
2 for the Regulation of the Senate Wing of the United  
3 States Capitol (prohibiting the taking of pictures in the  
4 Senate Chamber) be temporarily suspended for the sole  
5 and specific purpose of permitting photographs to be  
6 taken between the first and second sessions of the 106th  
7 Congress in order to allow the Senate Commission on Art  
8 to carry out its responsibilities to publish a Senate docu-  
9 ment containing works of art, historical objects, and exhib-  
10 its within the Senate Wing.

1        SEC. 2. The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate is au-  
2    thorized and directed to make the necessary arrangements  
3    to carry out this resolution.
