## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of  
Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment  
of the Senate.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2    *concurring), That when the House adjourns on the legisla-*  
3    *tive day of Friday, May 25, 2001, or Saturday, May 26,*  
4    *2001, on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent res-*  
5    *olution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand*  
6    *adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5, 2001, or until*  
7    *noon on the second day after Members are notified to reas-*  
8    *semble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,*  
9    *whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses*  
10   *or adjourns at the close of business on Saturday, May 26,*

1 2001, Sunday, May 27, 2001, or Tuesday, May 29, 2001,  
2 on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution  
3 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed  
4 or adjourned until noon on Tuesday, June 5, 2001, or  
5 until such time on that day as may be specified by its  
6 Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess  
7 or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after Members  
8 are notified to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this  
9 concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

10 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
11 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
12 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
13 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
14 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in  
15 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
