- Whereas parents who actively participate in the lives of their children deserve recognition and support;
- Whereas the establishment of a Parents Week would encourage parents to actively participate in the lives of their children; and
- Whereas the fourth week of September is an appropriate week to establish as Parents Week: Now, therefore, be it

1	Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
2	concurring), That it is the sense of Congress that—
3	(1) a Parents Week should be established to
4	recognize and support parents who actively partici-
5	pate in the lives of their children; and
6	(2) the President should issue a proclamation
7	calling on the people of the United States to observe
8	such a week with appropriate programs and activi-
9	ties.
