CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Wednesday, October 17, 2001, it stand ad-
4 journd until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 23, 2001,
5 for morning hour debate, or until Members are notified

1 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
2 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate
3 recesses or adjourns at the close of business on Wednes-
4 day, October 17, 2001, or Thursday, October 18, 2001,
5 on a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
6 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
7 or adjourned until 10 a.m. on Tuesday, October 23, 2001,
8 or at such other time on that day as may be specified by
9 its Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to recess
10 or adjourn, or until Members are notified to reassemble
11 pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, which-
12 ever occurs first.

13 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
14 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
15 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
16 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
17 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place
18 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
19 the public interest shall warrant it.
