- 1 Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate
- 2 concurring), That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
- 3 tive day of Wednesday, March 20, 2002, or Thursday,
- 4 March 21, 2002, on a motion offered pursuant to this con-
- 5 current resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee,

- 1 it stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, April 9, 2002,
- 2 or until Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
- 3 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
- 4 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns at
- 5 the close of business on Thursday, March 21, 2002, Fri-
- 6 day, March 22, 2002, or Saturday, March 23, 2002, on
- 7 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
- 8 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
- 9 or adjourned until noon on Monday, April 8, 2002, or at
- 10 such other time on that day as may be specified in the
- 11 motion to recess or adjourn, or until Members are notified
- 12 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
- 13 olution, whichever occurs first.
- 14 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 15 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
- 16 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
- 17 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
- 18 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble at such place
- 19 and time as they may designate whenever, in their opinion,
- 20 the public interest shall warrant it.
