## **CONCURRENT RESOLUTION**

- Expressing the sense of Congress supporting the 2002 World Basketball Championship and welcoming the 16 national teams competing.
- Whereas the 2002 World Basketball Championship will be held from August 29, 2002, through September 8, 2002, in Indianapolis, Indiana;
- Whereas 2002 marks the first time in the 50 year history of the World Basketball Championship it will be held in the United States;
- Whereas 16 national teams will be competing as part of the 62 game, 11 day event;
- Whereas the 2002 World Basketball Championship is expected to draw between 150,000 and 175,000 basketball

fans from throughout the United States and foreign nations; and

Whereas international sporting events such as the 2002 World Basketball Championship play an important role in continuing to foster positive international relationships and friendships between participating teams and fans: Now, therefore, be it
