6 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The President is authorized to
7 issue to the late Colonel William Mitchell, United States
8 Army, a posthumous commission in the grade of brigadier

1 general, effective as of the date of his death on February
2 19, 1936.

3 (b) PROHIBITION OF BENEFITS.—No person shall be
4 entitled to receive any bonus, gratuity, pay, allowances,
5 or other financial benefit by reason of the enactment of
6 this joint resolution.
