- 6 (a) Exception to Termination of Benefits
- 7 Upon Remarkiage.—Section 103(d) of title 38, United

- 1 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 2 lowing new paragraph:
- 3 "(6) The remarriage after age 55 of the surviving
- 4 spouse of a veteran shall not bar payment of benefits
- 5 under section 1311 of this title.".
- 6 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Paragraph (4) of
- 7 such section is amended by striking "this subsection" and
- 8 inserting "paragraph (2) or (3)".
