## A BILL

To amend titles 10 and 14, United States Code, to provide for the use of gold in the metal content of the Medal of Honor.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

### 3 **SECTION 1. GOLD CONTENT FOR MEDAL OF HONOR.**

4 (a) REQUIREMENT FOR GOLD CONTENT.—Sections  
5 3741, 6241, and 8741 of title 10, United States Code,  
6 and section 491 of title 14, United States Code, are each  
7 amended by inserting “the metal content of which is 90

1 percent gold and 10 percent alloy and” after “appropriate  
2 design,”.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
4 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to any award of  
5 the Medal of Honor after the date of the enactment of  
6 this Act.
