A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Orphan Drug Tax
- 5 Credit Act of 2001".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF HUMAN CLINICAL TRIALS QUALI-
- 7 FYING FOR ORPHAN DRUG CREDIT.
- 8 (a) In General.—Subclause (I) of section
- 9 45C(b)(2)(A)(ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is
- 10 amended to read as follows:

1	"(I) after the date that the appli-
2	cation is filed for designation under
3	such section 526, and".
4	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Clause (i) of sec-
5	tion 45C(b)(2)(A) of such Code is amended by inserting
6	"which is" before "being" and by inserting before the
7	comma at the end "and which is designated under section
8	526 of such Act".
9	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
10	this Act shall apply to amounts paid or incurred after the
11	date of the enactment of this Act.
