Mr. ROTHMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Alexandre Malofienko, Olga Matsko, and their son, Vladimir Malofienko.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR
4 ALEXANDRE MALOIFIENKO, OLGA MATSKO,
5 AND THEIR SON, VLADIMIR MALOIFIENKO.**

6 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act, Alexandre Malofienko, Olga Matsko, and their son,
9 Vladimir Malofienko shall each be eligible for issuance of
10 an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of

1 an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon
2 filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa
3 under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status
4 to lawful permanent resident.

5 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Alexandre
6 Malofienko, Olga Matsko, or their son, Vladimir
7 Malofienko enters the United States before the filing dead-
8 line specified in subsection (c), he or she shall be consid-
9 ered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if
10 otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status
11 under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
12 as of the date of the enactment of this Act.

13 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
14 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
15 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
16 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
17 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

18 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
19 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
20 idence to Alexandre Malofienko, Olga Matsko, and their
21 son, Vladimir Malofienko, the Secretary of State shall in-
22 struct the proper officer to reduce by 3, during the current
23 or next following fiscal year, the total number of immi-
24 grant visas that are made available to natives of the coun-
25 try of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immi-

1 gration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total
2 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-
3 tives of the country of the aliens' birth under section
4 202(e) of such Act.

5 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
6 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
7 parents, brothers, and sisters of Alexandre Malofienko,
8 Olga Matsko, and their son, Vladimir Malofienko shall
9 not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right,
10 privilege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality
11 Act.
