## A BILL

To increase discretionary funding for certain grant programs established under the “Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance Programs”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCREASE DISCRETIONARY FUNDING FOR CER-**2 **TAIN GRANT PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED**  
3 **UNDER THE "EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL**  
4 **STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AS-**  
5 **SISTANCE PROGRAMS".**6 Section 1001(a) of the Omnibus Crime Control and  
7 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3793(a)) is amended  
8 by adding at the end the following new paragraph:9 "“(25) There is authorized to be appropriated  
10 \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2002 to carry out subpart  
11 2 of part E of this title.”.
