A BILL

To restore the jurisdiction of the Consumer Product Safety Commission over amusement park rides which are at a fixed site, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 2 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**
- 3 This Act may be cited as the “National Amusement
- 4 Park Ride Safety Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. JURISDICTION OVER FIXED SITE AMUSEMENT**2 **RIDES.**

3 Section 3(a)(1) of the Consumer Product Safety Act
4 (15 U.S.C. 2052(a)(1)) is amended by striking “, and
5 which is not permanently fixed to a site. Such term does
6 not include such a device which is permanently fixed to
7 a site.” and inserting a period.

8 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

9 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Con-
10 sumer Product Safety Commission \$500,000 for each fis-
11 cal year to enable the Commission to carry out the Con-
12 sumer Product Safety Act as amended by this Act.
