## 1 SEC. 2. REPORT BY EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

- Not later than one year after the date of enactment
- 4 of this Act, the Equal Employment Opportunity Commis-
- 5 sion, using information supplied by the Department of
- 6 Labor, the Office of Management and Budget, and the
- 7 General Accounting Office, shall submit a report to the

- 10 201 et seq.) has been used by public and private sector
- 11 employers to foster or exacerbate pay inequities, especially
