1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. DEADLINE FOR FILING INCOME TAX RETURNS 4 FOR CALENDAR YEAR TAXPAYERS CHANGED 5 FROM APRIL 15TH TO FIRST MONDAY OF NO-6 VEMBER. 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6072 of the Internal Rev-8 enue Code of 1986 (relating to time for filing income tax returns) is amended in subsection (a) by striking "15th

10 day of April" and inserting "first Monday in November".
