To change the deadline for income tax returns for calendar year taxpayers from the 15th of April to the first Monday in November.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEADLINE FOR FILING INCOME TAX RETURNS**
4 **FOR CALENDAR YEAR TAXPAYERS CHANGED**
5 **FROM APRIL 15TH TO FIRST MONDAY OF NO-**
6 **VEMBER.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 6072 of the Internal Rev-
8 enue Code of 1986 (relating to time for filing income tax
9 returns) is amended in subsection (a) by striking “15th
10 day of April” and inserting “first Monday in November”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) shall apply to taxable years beginning after
3 December 31, 2001.
