## A BILL

To increase the numerical limitation on the number of asylees whose status may be adjusted to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Increase in Numerical

5       Limitation for Asylees Adjustment Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN NUMERICAL LIMITATION ON ASYLEE**2 **ADJUSTMENT.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 209(b) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1159(b)) is amended by striking “10,000” and inserting “25,000”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall apply to fiscal years beginning with 7 fiscal year 2001.
