- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicaid Safety Net
- 5 Improvement Act of 2001".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASE IN FLOOR FOR TREATMENT AS AN EX-
- 7 TREMELY LOW DSH STATE TO 3 PERCENT IN
- 8 FISCAL YEAR 2002.
- 9 (a) Increase in DSH Floor.—Section 1923(f)(5)
- 10 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396r-4(f)(5)), as

- 1 added by section 701(a)(2) of the Medicare, Medicaid, and
- 2 SCHIP Benefits Improvement and Protection Act of 2000
- 3 (as enacted into law by section 1(a)(6) of Public Law 106–
- 4 554), is amended—
- 5 (1) by striking "fiscal year 1999" and inserting
- 6 "fiscal year 2000";
- 7 (2) by striking "August 31, 2000" and insert-
- 8 ing "August 31, 2001";
- 9 (3) by striking "1 percent" each place it ap-
- pears and inserting "3 percent"; and
- 11 (4) by striking "fiscal year 2001" and inserting
- 12 "fiscal year 2002".
- 13 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 14 subsection (a) take effect on October 1, 2001, and apply
- 15 to DSH allotments under title XIX of the Social Security
- 16 Act for fiscal year 2002 and each fiscal year thereafter.
