To establish a uniform closing time for the operation of polls on the date of the election of the President and Vice President.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Uniform Poll Closing
- 5 Act of 2001".
- 6 SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF UNIFORM POLL CLOSING TIME
- 7 ON PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION DAY.
- 8 For each election of a President and Vice President
- 9 held on the Tuesday next after the 1st Monday in Novem-
- 10 ber (beginning with the election in 2004), the polls in each

- 1 State (other than Alaska and Hawaii) and the District of
- 2 Columbia shall close at 11 p.m. eastern standard time.
