- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 211.
- 4 Section 211(c) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
- 5 7545(c)) is amended as follows:
- 6 (1) By adding at the end of paragraph (1) the
- 7 following: "The Administrator shall amend the regu-
- 8 lations under this paragraph as promptly as prac-
- 9 ticable after the date of enactment of this sentence

- to prohibit the use of methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE) as a fuel additive.".
- 3 (2) By adding the following new subparagraph 4 at the end of paragraph (2):
- 5 "(D) The Administrator shall prohibit under para-
- 6 graph (1) any additive in gasoline registered under sub-
- 7 section (a) after the enactment of this subparagraph un-
- 8 less it has been determined (through scientific testing and
- 9 peer review) not to have any adverse effects on the pub-
- 10 lic.".
