Mr. BEREUTER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1992 to authorize the Secretary of the Army to reimburse non-Federal interests for managing recreation facilities and natural resources at water resource development projects, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. NON-FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT.

4 Section 225 of the Water Resources Development Act
5 of 1992 (33 U.S.C. 2328; 106 Stat. 4838) is amended
6 by adding at the end the following:

1 “(d) NON-FEDERAL REIMBURSEMENT.—The Sec-
2 retary may pay from Federal appropriations for the non-
3 Federal share of work carried out under this section by
4 a non-Federal interest if the Secretary has entered into
5 an executed agreement with the non-Federal interest that
6 provides for reimbursement of such payment. The Sec-
7 retary may pay from Federal appropriations for expendi-
8 tures for work undertaken by a non-Federal interest in
9 accordance with this section with subsequent reimburse-
10 ment by the non-Federal interest in accordance with an
11 agreement executed under this section.”.
