- 6 ing standards-setting entity on whose standards issuers of
- 7 securities and other regulated persons are permitted to
- 8 rely for purposes of complying with generally accepted ac-
- 9 counting principles in the preparation of periodic reports

- 1 and other statements required to be submitted under the
- 2 Federal securities laws.
