A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act to require that fragrances containing known toxic substances or allergens be labeled accordingly.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safe Notification and
5 Information for Fragrances Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LABELING OF FRAGRANCES WITH RESPECT TO**
2 **KNOWN TOXIC SUBSTANCES OR ALLERGENS.**

3 Section 602 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
4 Act (21 U.S.C. 362) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 “(g) If it is a fragrance that contains a known toxic
7 substance, unless it bears labeling stating that fact and
8 the common or usual name of such substance.

9 “(h) If it is a fragrance that contains a known aller-
10 gen, unless it bears labeling stating that fact and the com-
11 mon or usual name of such allergen, or the name specified
12 in any definition and standard of identity for the allergen
13 under section 401, as applicable.”.

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
