A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to convey a small parcel of land at the United States Military Academy to the Village of Highland Falls, New York.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, UNITED STATES MILITARY
- 4 ACADEMY, NEW YORK.
- 5 (a) Conveyance Authorized.—The Secretary of
- 6 the Army may convey, without consideration, to the Vil-
- 7 lage of Highland Falls, New York (in this section referred
- 8 to as the "Village"), all right, title and interest of the
- 9 United States in and to a parcel of real property, including

- 1 any improvements thereon, located in the Town of High-
- 2 land, New York, and consisting of approximately 300
- 3 acres for the purpose of permitting the Village to use the
- 4 property to promote economic development.
- 5 (b) Description of Property.—The exact acreage
- 6 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
- 7 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
- 8 factory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
- 9 borne by the Secretary.
- 10 (c) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
- 11 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
- 12 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
- 13 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
- 14 interests of the United States.
