A BILL

To amend the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 to promote better nutrition among school children participating in the school breakfast and lunch programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Better Nutrition for
5 School Children Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. REGULATIONS RELATING TO SERVICE OF COMPETI-**
2 **TIVE FOODS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 10 of the Child Nutrition
4 Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1779) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “(throughout
6 the entire school, including the school grounds, until
7 the end of the school day)” after “participating
8 schools”;

9 (2) by striking subsection (b); and

10 (3) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
11 section (b).

12 (b) REGULATIONS.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
14 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-
15 retary of Agriculture shall promulgate such regula-
16 tions as are necessary to implement the amendments
17 made by subsection (a).

18 (2) PROCEDURE.—The promulgation of the reg-
19 ulations and the administration of the amendments
20 made by this section shall be made without regard
21 to chapter 35 of title 44, United States Code (com-
22 monly known as the “Paperwork Reduction Act”).

23 (3) CONGRESSIONAL REVIEW OF AGENCY RULE-
24 MAKING.—In carrying out this subsection, the Sec-

- 1 retary shall use the authority provided under section
- 2 808(2) of title 5, United States Code.
