To delay any legal effect or implementation of a notice of rights and request for disposition form of the Immigration and Naturalization Service if an alien admits to being in the United States illegally, gives up the right to a hearing before departure, and requests to return to his country without a hearing.

1	SECTION 1. DELAY IN LEGAL EFFECT OR IMPLEMENTA-
2	TION OF NOTICE OF RIGHTS AND REQUEST
3	FOR DISPOSITION FORM OF THE IMMIGRA-

5	TAIN CASES.
6	In any case in which an alien executes a notice of
7	rights and request for disposition form of the Immigration
8	and Naturalization Service admitting to being in the
9	United States illegally, giving up the right to a hearing
10	before departure, and requesting to return to the alien's
11	country without a hearing, such form shall not be legally
12	binding on the alien and no departure or return may be
13	implemented—
14	(1) unless the form was certified after the alien
15	consulted with an attorney or other legal representa-

17	States and such consultation was conducted in the
18	native language of the alien or with the assistance
19	of an interpreter; or
