A BILL

To provide for the establishment of a new Department of Veterans Affairs medical facility for veterans in south Texas.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	$tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled,$
3	SECTION 1. NEW DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
4	MEDICAL FACILITY IN SOUTH TEXAS.
5	(a) Project Authorization.—The Secretary of
6	Veterans Affairs is authorized—
7	(1) to acquire a site in south Texas suitable for
8	a medical facility; and
9	(2) to construct a medical facility on such site.

- 1 (b) Funding.—There are authorized to be appro-
- 2 priated such sums as may be necessary for the purposes
- 3 of subsection (a), but the amount appropriated for the
- 4 construction of the medical facility may not exceed the
- 5 product of (1) the number of beds to be included in the
- 6 facility, and (2) \$290,000.
- 7 (c) Definition.—For purposes of this section, the
- 8 term "medical facility" has the meaning given the term
- 9 in section 8101(3) of title 38, United States Code.
