  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Facilities
  - 5 Emergency Power Supply Act of 2001".
  - 6 SEC. 2. STUDY OF FEDERAL BACKUP GENERATION.
  - 7 The Administrator of the General Services Adminis-
  - 8 tration shall undertake a study to identify all potential

- 3 tors. The Administrator shall submit a report within 90
