A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to limit the hospital ownership exception to physician self-referral restrictions to interests purchased on terms generally available to the public.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hospital Investment
5 Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITING THE HOSPITAL OWNERSHIP EXCEPTION**2 **TO PHYSICIAN SELF-REFERRAL RESTRICTIONS TO INTERESTS PURCHASED ON TERMS**
3 **GENERALLY AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.**5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1877(d)(3) of the Social

6 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395nn(d)(3)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subparagraph (A);

9 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
10 paragraph (B) and inserting “; and”; and11 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
12 paragraph:13 “(C) the ownership or investment interest
14 is purchased on terms generally available to the
15 public at the time.”.16 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
17 subsection (a) apply to ownership and investment interests
18 purchased on or after July 12, 2001.
