A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to the authority of probation officers and pretrial services officers to carry firearms.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the “Probation Officers’
5 Protection Act of 2001”.

6 SEC. 2. NEW AUTHORITY FOR PROBATION AND PRETRIAL
7 SERVICES OFFICERS.

8 (a) SECTION 3603 AMENDMENT.—Paragraph (9) of
9 section 3603 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
10 to read as follows:

1 “(9) be authorized to carry firearms upon satis-
2 factorily completing any safety and proficiency train-
3 ing or testing proscribed by the Director of the Ad-
4 ministrative Office of the United States Courts;
5 and”.

6 (b) SECTION 3154 AMENDMENT.—Paragraph (13) of
7 section 3154 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
8 to read as follows:

9 “(13) be authorized to carry firearms upon sat-
10 isfactorily completing any safety and proficiency
11 training or testing proscribed by the Director of the
12 Administrative Office of the United States Courts.”.
