## A BILL

To provide for the appointment of an Assistant United States Attorney for each judicial district for the purpose of prosecuting firearms offenses.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Gun Crime Prosecu-

5       tion Act of 2001”.

1     **SEC. 2. APPOINTMENT OF ASSISTANT UNITED STATES AT-**  
2                   **TORNEYS TO PROSECUTE FIREARMS OF-**  
3                   **FENSES.**

4     (a) IN GENERAL.—The United States Attorney for  
5     each judicial district shall—

6                 (1) appoint 1 Assistant United States Attorney  
7     in addition to any other Assistant United States At-  
8     torneys appointed for the judicial district;

9                 (2) assign the additional Assistant United  
10    States Attorney responsibility for prosecuting only  
11    offenses under chapter 44 of title 18, United States  
12    Code, and any other offense under Federal law in-  
13    volving firearms or ammunition; and

14                 (3) require the additional Assistant United  
15    States Attorney in the prosecution of such offenses,  
16    to give priority to—

17                     (A) crimes of violence (as defined in sec-  
18    tion 16 of such title) committed by individuals  
19    who have previously been convicted of such a  
20    crime; and

21                     (B) offenses by individuals who have pre-  
22    viously been convicted of a crime punishable by  
23    imprisonment for more than 1 year.

24     (b) LIMITATION ON AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-  
25    TIONS.—To carry out this section, there are authorized  
26    to be appropriated to the Attorney General \$8,300,000 for

1 each of fiscal years 2002 through 2005. Amounts appro-  
2 priated pursuant to this subsection are authorized to re-  
3 main available until expended.
