A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to waive the obstetrician requirement insofar as it prevents DSH designation in the case of certain rural hospitals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. WAIVER OF OBSTETRICIAN REQUIREMENT IN
SOFAR AS IT PREVENTS DESIGNATION OF

CERTAIN RURAL HOSPITALS AS DISPROPOR
TIONATE SHARE HOSPITALS.

Section 1923(d)(2)(A) of the Social Security Act (42)

U.S.C. 1396r-4(d)(2)(A)) is amended—

(1) by striking "or" at the end of clause (i);

1	(2) by striking the period at the end of clause
2	(ii) and inserting "; or"; and
3	(3) by adding at the end the following new
4	clause:
5	"(iii) which the State has designated as a
6	critical access hospital (under section
7	1820(c)(2)) or as an essential rural health care
8	provider (under applicable State law).".
