Mr. REYES introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To modify the benefits provided under the NAFTA Transitional Adjustment Assistance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATIONS OF NAFTA TRANSITIONAL AD-**
4 **JUSTMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

5 (a) EXTENSION OF PROGRAM.—Section 285(c)(2)(A)
6 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2771 note) is amend-
7 ed by striking “2001” and inserting “2006”.

8 (b) TRAINING AND TRADE READJUSTMENT ALLOW-
9 ANCES.—Section 250(d) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19

1 U.S.C. 2331(d)) is amended by striking paragraphs (2)
2 and (3) and inserting the following:

3 “(2) Training described in section 236, except
4 that the total amount of payments for training
5 under this subchapter shall not exceed \$60,000,000
6 for any fiscal year.

7 “(3) Trade adjustment reallowances described
8 in sections 231 through 234, except that—

9 “(A) subject to subparagraph (C), in ap-
10 plying section 233(a)(2), ‘130’ shall be sub-
11 stituted for ‘104’;

12 “(B) subject to subparagraph (C), in ap-
13 plying section 233(a)(3), ‘52’ shall be sub-
14 stituted for ‘26’ each place it appears; and

15 “(C) in order to assist an adversely af-
16 fected worker who has limited English pro-
17 ficiency to complete training approved for the
18 worker, or to assist an adversely affected work-
19 er to complete a program of remedial education
20 described in section 236(a)(5)(D)—

21 “(i) in applying section 233(a)(2),
22 ‘182’ shall be substituted for ‘104’; and

23 “(ii) in applying section 233(a)(3),
24 ‘104’ shall be substituted for ‘26’ each
25 place it appears.”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendments made by section 1 shall apply with
3 respect to an individual receiving trade readjustment al-
4 lowances pursuant to subchapter D of chapter 2 of title
5 II of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2331) on or after
6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
