3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION OF DUTY ON (3-(1-METHYLETHYL)-**  
4 **1H-2,1,3-BENZOTHIADIAZIN-4(3H)-ONE 2,2 DI-**  
5 **OXIDE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
9 new heading:

“	9902.33.25	(3-(1-methylethyl)-1H-2,1,3-benzothiadiazin-4(3H)-one 2,2 di-oxide (CAS No. 50723-80-3) (provided for in subheading 2934.90.11) .....	4.5%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
