3 **SECTION 1. REDUCTION OF DUTY ON (3-(1-METHYLETHYL)-
4 1H-2,1,3-BENZOTHIADIAZIN-4(3H)-ONE 2,2 DI-
5 OXIDE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
