A BILL

To provide for an educational center in Haleakala National Park in Hawaii.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EDUCATIONAL CENTER IN HALEAKALA NA-
- 4 TIONAL PARK.
- 5 The Act entitled "An Act to designate and establish
- 6 that portion of the Hawaii National Park on the island
- 7 of Maui, in the State of Hawaii, as the Haleakala National
- 8 Park, and for other purposes", approved September 13,
- 9 1960 (Public Law 86-744), is amended by adding at the
- 10 end the following new section:

1 "SEC. 3. EDUCATIONAL CENTER.

- 2 "The Secretary of the Interior may provide for the
- 3 planning, construction, maintenance, and operation of an
- 4 educational center at the headquarters of Haleakala Na-
- 5 tional Park to provide educational exhibits and materials
- 6 about the park. The educational center may include an
- 7 auditorium to show educational movies related to the

8 park.".
