- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MEDICARE COVERAGE OF IMMUNO-
- 4 SUPPRESSIVE DRUGS FOR TRANSPLANTS
- 5 NOT PAID FOR UNDER MEDICARE.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(s)(2)(J) of the So-
- 7 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(s)(2)(J)) is amended

- 1 by striking "for which payment is made under this title"
- 2 and inserting "whether or not payment is made for the
- 3 transplant under this title".
- 4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 5 subsection (a) shall apply to prescription drugs furnished
- 6 on or after October 1, 2001, regardless of when the organ
- 7 transplant was performed.
