A BILL

To amend the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 to authorize the appropriation of funds for the program to collect information relating to nonimmigrant foreign students and to provide for a GAO review of such program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Student Data-
5 base Funding Act of 2001”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUNDING OF PROGRAM TO COLLECT INFORMATION**
2 **RELATING TO NONIMMIGRANT FOREIGN STU-**
3 **DENTS AND OTHER EXCHANGE PROGRAM**
4 **PARTICIPANTS.**

5 (a) FUNDING.—Section 641(e) of the Illegal Immi-
6 gration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996
7 is amended to read as follows:

8 “(e) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
9 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
10 necessary to carry out this section.”.

11 (b) REVIEW AND REPORT.—Not later than 1 year
12 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the General
13 Accounting Office shall conduct a review of the operation
14 of the program. Not later than 60 days after completion
15 of such review, the Comptroller General shall submit a re-
16 port of the findings of such review to the Congress.

17 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 641(g) of
18 the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsi-
19 bility Act of 1996 is amended—

20 (1) by striking paragraph (2);

21 (2) by striking “(1) EXPANSION OF PRO-
22 GRAM.—”; and

23 (3) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) and
24 (B) as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively.
