A BILL

To provide benefits to public safety officers who die or become disabled as a result of certain injuries.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Public Safety Officer
- 5 Protection Act of 2001".
- 6 SEC. 2. BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN INJURIES.
- 7 Subpart 1 of part L of the title I of the Omnibus
- 8 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act (42 U.S.C. 3796 et
- 9 seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 "SEC. 1206. BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN INJURIES.

- 2 "Notwithstanding the rules and regulations issued
- 3 pursuant to this subpart, if a public safety officer develops
- 4 cancer and either dies or becomes permanently and totally
- 5 disabled as a result of the cancer, such officer's death or
- 6 disability shall be presumed to be the direct and proximate
- 7 result of a personal injury sustained in the line of duty.
- 8 An officer described in the preceding sentence or such offi-
- 9 cer's family, as the case may be, shall be eligible for bene-
- 10 fits under this subpart".
