5	Section 9(b)(3) of the Richard B. Russell National
6	School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1758(b)(3)) is amended by
7	adding at the end the following: "The amount of a basic
8	allowance provided under section 403 of title 37, United
9	States Code, on behalf of an individual who is a member
10	of the uniformed services for housing that is acquired or
11	constructed under the authority of subchapter IV of chap-
12	ter 169 of title 10, United States Code, or any other re-
13	lated provision of law, shall not be considered to be income
14	for purposes of determining the eligibility of a child of the
15	individual for free or reduced price lunches under this
16	Act.".
