To direct the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to waive repayment requirements in connection with a grant made to Granada Hills Community Hospital in Granada Hills, California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRANADA HILLS COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, CALI-**
4 **FORNIA.**

5 (a) **AUTHORITY TO GRANT WAIVER.**—Notwith-
6 standing any other provision of law, the Director of the
7 Federal Emergency Management Agency shall waive the
8 application of any term of the grant agreement identified

1 in subsection (b) that would otherwise require the repay-
2 ment of amounts received under the agreement in the
3 event that the hospital identified in subsection (b) is con-
4 veyed to a for-profit entity.

5 (b) IDENTIFICATION OF GRANT AGREEMENT.—The
6 grant agreement referred to in subsection (a) is the agree-
7 ment for grant number FEMA-1008-DR, P.A.037-90319,
8 which was provided to Granada Hills Community Hospital
9 in Granada Hills, California, under the seismic hazards
10 mitigation program for hospitals administered by the Fed-
11 eral Emergency Management Agency.
