## A BILL

To ensure that individuals scheduled for certain flights are not penalized for canceling or rescheduling such flights.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN FEES.
- 4 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Transportation
- 5 shall take such action as is necessary to ensure that an
- 6 air carrier that receives assistance under section 101(a)(2)
- 7 of the Air Transportation Safety and System Stabilization
- 8 Act (Public Law 107–42) shall—

1	(1) refund the amount paid by an individual for
2	air transportation canceled between September 11,
3	2001, and September 11, 2002; and
4	(2) not assess any fee to a passenger who can-
5	celed or rescheduled such air transportation.
6	(b) Definitions.—In this section the terms "air
7	carrier" and "air transportation" have the meanings such
8	terms have under section 40102 of title 49, United States
9	Code.
